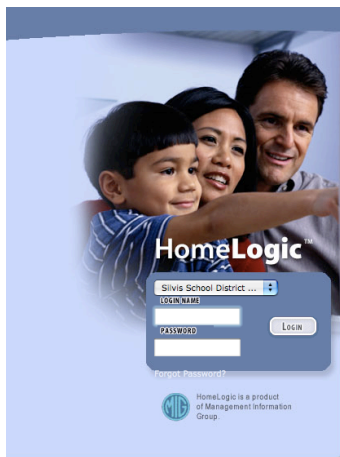


Accessing the Silvis School District Online Student Information System. (HomeLogic)

1. Using your web browser navigate to this url: <http://216.124.186.8/homelogic/>
2. You should see this in your browser:

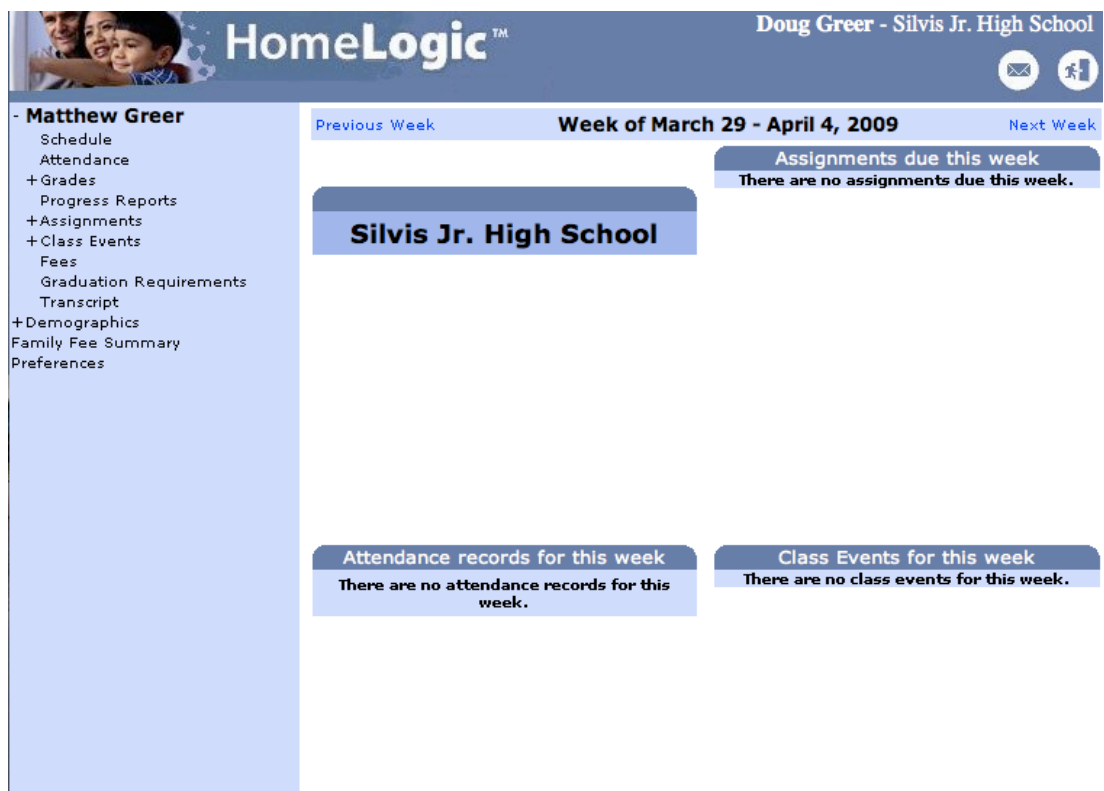

(These credentials are issued by the school, after a completed HomeLogic permission slip is submitted to the office)

3. Enter your login name and password and click on the login button.
4. You should now see a similar screen to this:



In the example you will note the name: “Matthew Greer” in the left window pane, this will be your student’s name. Parents with multiple students will have them all listed here.

In the example you will note the name “Doug Greer” at the top right area of the screen. This is the name of the parent currently logged into the system.

5. Once logged in you can access information about your students by navigating the links located in the left window pane of your screen.

Clicking on the links will expand them and provide more options and information to explore. The example to the right shows the grades link expanded.

6. To access a list of teacher email addresses, click on the envelope button on the top right of the screen.



7. When you are done using the system, you need to log out using the button with the person opening a door located at the top right of the screen.
